Notes

1. The Messiah has a message for the world (Isa 49:1).
2. The Messiah is the Lord's hidden weapon—a secret arrow (Isa 49:2).
 - a. His words are a sword (cf. Rev 2:16; 19:15, 21). Yours can be too.
3. The Messiah is the ideal Israel personified (Isa 49:3).
4. The Messiah's apparent failure was an eternal victory (Isa 49:4–6).
5. The Lion had to be a Lamb. The King had to be a servant (Isa 49:7).
 - b. As the Body of Christ, we should follow His example (Eph 5:1–2).
